

Prayer Title:

Opening	
Thanksgiving • <i>Thank the Father for who He is.</i> • <i>Thank the Father for another opportunity to meet with Him in prayer</i> • <i>Address him as Father, not as God.</i>	
Praise • <i>Praise the Father for what he has done</i> • <i>Sing a song of praise</i>	

Forgiveness

- *Ask the Father for forgiveness of your sin.*
- *Explain what you assume your most recent sins have been.*
- *Thank God that the sacrifice of Jesus Christ has blotted out your transgressions*
- *Promise to repent (not commit the same sin over and over again)*
- *If you have wronged someone else, schedule time to ask for their forgiveness*
- *If you are married, but you are involved in an argument with your spouse, stop and ask your spouse to forgive you so that your prayer won't be hindered*
- *If someone else has hurt you or said something about you falsely, state that you will forgive them*

Your Case	
Statement • <i>Explain the problem or issue.</i> • <i>State the steps that you've taken to resolve the issue in accordance with the Word of God.</i>	

Evidence

- *Provide proof that the problem or issue is occurring.*
- Provide up to three pieces of evidence

Confession

- *Say what the Word of God says about your situation*
- *Say two to three scriptures that include promises God made to you as a believer*
- *Say two to three scriptures that include covenant rights you have as a child of God and citizen of the heavenly kingdom of God*

Request

- *Ask the Father to move on your behalf, but don't tell Him how to do it.*
- *Provide two or three examples of how God moved on the behalf of people in the Bible that experienced a similar problem*
- *Ask the Father to show you other actions you can take now to be the change you want to see*
- *Ask God to assign his angels to help accomplish what it is you are praying about*
- *If necessary, bind the adversary and his principalities that are at work behind the scenes causing chaos*
- *Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you additional steps you can take to resolve the issue*

Closing	
Thanksgiving • <i>Thank the Father in advance for his answer to your issue/problem</i> • <i>Use a name of God that relates to your plea. (Example: Jehovah Jireh)</i>	
Wait • <i>Wait patiently and silently for a few moments.</i> • <i>Meditate on the answer.</i> • <i>Visualize your situation being resolved.</i> • <i>Remind yourself that the problem or issue is temporary and fleeting.</i>
